3. Deadline for Submitting Your Presentation

The deadline of applying for presentations at the meeting and for submitting abstracts are as follows. Presenters must be regular members (general/student), group members or supporting members of the Japanese Society for Environmental Education. If you are a non-member and wish to become a presenter, please refer to the application details (https://www.jsfee.jp/general/membership-application) on the society webpage and complete the enrollment procedure by Thursday, July 1. Presentation is limited to one per person and either as oral presentation or poster presentation. Presenting in both oral session and poster session (total two or more presentations) is NOT permitted.

(1) Applying for an Oral Presentation

- If you wish to make an oral presentation, please log in to My Page from the Registration webpage using the ID and password sent AFTER registered for participation. Then proceed to "Presentation Application" to submit the necessary information.
- Oral presentations can be made in either English or Japanese. If you make an English presentation, it will be allocated in the English Session regardless of the theme. Please note that presenting both in English and Japanese in one session is not permitted.
- Presentations will be made using the Zoom online conferencing system.
- Each research presentation is 15 minutes (10 min presentation and 5 min Q & A).

(2) Applying for a Poster Presentation

- If you wish to make a poster presentation, please log in to My Page from the Registration webpage using the ID and password sent AFTER registered for participation. Then proceed to "Presentation Application" to submit the necessary information. A poster presentation can be either in English or Japanese.
- Poster should be created and submitted IN ADVANCE of the meeting. It will be uploaded on the special webpage (currently under preparation) and questions will be submitted through that webpage. Where to submit the poster will be announced later.

(3) Applying for a Project Research

- Only the representative should apply for a group that wishes to make a presentation or to hold a small meeting as project research. Representative is limited to a member of the society. Representative should log in to My Page from the Registration webpage using the ID and

password sent AFTER registered for participation. Then proceed to "Presentation Application for Project Research" to submit the necessary information.

(4) Notice of Registration Reception

- Once you complete your registration, we will inform you of the acceptance number with notice (e-mail) of application completion.
- Pease note that the title of your presentation (oral presentation, poster presentation and Project Research) can't be change once registered.


(5) Registration of the Abstract

- If you are the representative of your presentation(s) (oral/poster presentation and/or Project Research), please log in to My Page from the Annual Meeting Registration webpage, proceed to "Presentation Application" and submit your abstract. Please note that the abstracts should not contain any figures or tables and should fit within a single page. If there are too many line breaks or paragraphs, it will not fit within 1 page.
- If you register for BOTH "oral presentation or poster presentation" AND "Research Project", please submit the abstract for each of them from My Page of the Annual Meeting Registration webpage.
- If submission is completed, you will receive a confirmation e-mail with information about points to keep in mind until your presentation. The deadline for submitting your abstract(s) is 6 pm on Friday, July 23.
- Your presentation title and presenter(s) can't be changed when submitting your abstract(s). Only your abstract(s) can be submitted.

(6) Other Notes

- For group members and supporting members, only one person per group can present only one oral/poster presentation.
- Presenters in oral session and poster session must be members of the society. Other copresenters do not necessarily have to be the member of the society.
